## **Joseph Bottone** poet

**Joseph Bottone** was born in Brooklyn, New York, attended university in sporadic fashion and was educated in the streets and wild places in the Catskill Mountains. Associated with the Beat poets, he read and published his poetry through St. Mark's Church in the Bowery. For 30 years he cultivated an inner life and returned to writing with a deeper sense of the Spiritual in his work. His work has been published in the *Paris Review*, the *Grapevine* in Tuscany, Italy and throughout the United States. His books include *Solitude in IV Parts*, *Australia*, *Light as Air* and most recently *Wild Honey - Encounters with the Divine*. Joseph Bottone resides in Pecos, NM and is Poet in Residence at Camaldoli Hermitage, Big Sur, CA for 3 months each year.
