

Hannah is an avid and versatile chamber musician who performs regularly with many ensembles, including the San Francisco Chamber Orchestra, San Francisco Contemporary Music Players, Zoco Ensemble, and Magik\*Magik Orchestra. From 2006-2010 she was cellist with the renowned Del Sol String Quartet, during which time the quartet performed more than 50 world premieres.

**About the Scordatura Project**

One hundred years ago, Zoltán Kodály composed his *Sonata for Solo Cello*, one of the most significant works written for the instrument since the Bach Suites. In celebration of this centenary, cellist Hannah Addario-Berry has created a program that showcases the 1915 Sonata with companion works created by dynamic young composers. The program is being presented in a solo concert tour around the United States and Canada.

At the end of the tour, the program will be recorded in a new solo cello CD, titled *Scordatura*.
