Gary Glazner poet

Gary Glazner is the founder and Executive Director of the Alzheimer's Poetry Project, (APP). The APP was the recipient of the 2013, Rosalinde Gilbert Innovations in Alzheimer's Disease Caregiving Legacy Award and the 2012 MetLife Foundation Creativity and Aging in America Leadership Award in the category of Community Engagement. The National Endowment for the Arts listed the APP as a "best practice." NBC's *Today* show, and NPR's *All Things Considered* have featured segments on Glazner's work. In 2013, the U.S. Poet Laure-ate, Natasha Trethewey, chose the APP for the initial broadcast of her PBS NewsHour series, "Where Poetry Lives." Harper Collins, W.W. Norton and Salon have published his work. Glazner is the author of *Dementia Arts: Celebrating Creativity in Elder Care*, Health Professionals Press, 2014. To date the APP has held programming in 26 states and internationally in Australia, Germany, Poland, and South Korea serving over 25,000 people living with dementia.
