He has given recitals at numerous European music festivals and concert series, including the Val Tidone Festival in Italy, Jeunesse musicales in Switzerland, and Klavierfestival Lindlar, Haus Blankenheim Saarbrücken, Meisterschüler am Klavier Karlstadt, Haus Steingraeber Bayreuth in Germany.
