Patrick Posey is a versatile saxophonist and multi-instrumentalist who has performed as a soloist, recitalist, and orchestral musician in the US and across the world. Based in New York City, he performs regularly in venues at Lincoln Center and Carnegie Hall, as well as the Museum of Modern Art, (le) poisson rouge, and Galapagos Art Space. He has performed with numerous contemporary music ensembles including AXIOM, the American Contemporary Music Ensemble, Le Train Bleu, and Ensemble ACJW, in addition to performing with orchestras under the baton of such conductors as Alan Gilbert, Reinbert DeLeeuw, and James Conlon. Recent appearances at Carnegie Hall have included concerts with composers John Adams, Thomas Ades, and Peter Eotvos leading performances of their own works. In addition to performing as a western classical musician, Posey is a regular collaborator with Iraqi oud virtuoso Rahim Al Haj. Formerly a member of the performance faculties of the University of New Mexico and University of Windsor, Patrick Posey has been Director of Orchestral Activities and Planning at The Juilliard School. This fall he will become vice president of artistic planning and educational programs at the Music Academy of the West in Santa Barbara, CA.
