Ray Johnson poet

Born into a large, working class family near Milwaukee's lakeshore, Raymond Johnson was tempered by long cold winters and humid summers. After earning a degree in Spanish and Italian at the University of Wisconsin, he moved to Las Vegas, NV and rejoined his family. He had spent the previous year at UCLA as an Italian teaching assistant and graduate student. Academia was not his true fit and after experiencing instrumental life changes, Mr. Johnson began a continuing journey in carpentry and woodworking, alongside two of his brothers. He moved to Albuquerque in 1983, retired from Albuquerque Public Schools, and now lives in Rio Rancho. Mr. Johnson's poems are lyrical, with depth of meaning and simple teaching. They stem from 50 years of observation, living and listening for the voice of the muse. He believes that a message is found in the spoken word, through sound and meter, which is worth stowing away in mind's memory, to be brought forth at the right instant of yet another juxtaposition of love, compassion and search for the ominous chord. And so he writes.
