## **Chiwan Choi** Spoken Word

Chiwan Choi was born in Seoul, Korea. He immigrated to Paraguay at the age of five and shortly thereafter to the United States. He earned an MFA at New York University. After publishing two books of poems, Choi sought to share his work beyond the traditional book-focused model of poetry publishing. Choi is cofounding editor of Writ Large Press, which also organizes literary gatherings in downtown Los Angeles, including the Grand Park Downtown BookFest, the publishing project PUBLISH!, and the Downtown Literary Alchemy Laboratory. His columns have appeared in *Cultural Weekly*. Choi lives in Los Angeles.

## **Canticles of the Sky** for 4 Cello Choirs (2015)

John Luther Adams (b. 1953)

In the Arctic sky, the low angle of the sun and heavy ice crystals in the air often produce vivid halls, arcs and sundogs (parhelia). Sometimes these phenomena create the illusion of multiple suns. "Sky With Four Suns" is a musical evocation of such an apparition, from sunrise to sunset. Similar visions also occur at night, which is the image behind "Sky With Four Moons."
