Flight of Birds for violin and echo (1979)

Flight of Birds is a work for violin and echo written in 1979 that aims to center on the essential qualities of the violin and reflect them about a room. The piece is one of a series of works for instruments and electronics in which the instrument is not masked by the electronics but is enhanced and supported by them.

The combination of the violin and its echoes represent the geometric/non-geometric flights of birds we see in the sky which eventually disappear.

The work is a segment of Demeter's Lament, a theater piece for voice, instruments and electronics that was premiered by the Relache Ensemble in 1991. In that context the work represents Demeter, Goddess of the Earth, who lost her daughter. Flight of Birds is the search for a missing child.
