## James Burbank Spoken Word

James Burbank is an Albuquerque multi-media artist, poet and writer whose long poem, *Untitled Outbursts*, performed last year at Chatter, appears this month on *Dispatches from the Poetry Wars* ([dispatchespoetrywars.com](http://dispatchespoetrywars.com)). His most recent book, *OxBow Poems: Slow Walks on the Rio Grande* (Duende Press, 2015) features Burbank's photography, poems and essays. He has done voice work featured in the PBS documentary, *Osimi*, and the short film, *The History of What's a Gonna Happen*, to promote Albuquerque sculptor Ed Haddaway's work that has been selected for the Venice Biennale 2019. Burbank's poetry/photography assemblages have been shown at the April Price Gallery, ACOG, and New Mexico Arts League Gallery. He lives with his life partner Jane and his incorrigible cat Ria in a mud house near the Rio Grande.
