Hakim Bellamy, the inaugural Poet Laureate of Albuquerque, NM (2012–2014), is a national and regional Poetry Slam Champion and recognized author and performer. Bellamy received honorable mention for the University of New Mexico Paul Bartlett Ré Peace Prize, a W. K. Kellogg Foundation Fellowship, the Food Justice Residency at Santa Fe Art Institute, and a Citizen Artist Fellowship from the Kennedy Center for the Arts. His poetry has also been featured on *AlterNet, Truthout*, and *CounterPunch*. Bellamy is on-air host for the New Mexico PBS show, *iCOLORES!*, and does acting and voice over work in addition to his poetry. Bellamy holds an M.A. in Communications from the University of New Mexico and is the founding president of Beyond Poetry LLC.
