Poul Ruders is one of today's most highly acclaimed composers. His operatic setting of The Handmaid's Tale has been hailed as "a riveting, kaleidoscopic score" by The New York Times. To be conducted by Paul Daniel and directed by Darko Tresnjak, The Thirteenth Child is Ruders' fifth opera and our sixteenth world premiere.
