Joel Beckett has performed, taught, and lectured throughout North America and Europe. He is a graduate of the Cleveland Institute of Music, where he received his Bachelor and Master of Music degrees with honors, and was awarded the Rubenstein prize for cello performance. He is a member, with pianist Carla McElhane and violinist Cámelo de los Santos, of the "classical band" REVEL, an ensemble dedicated to playing concerts in an intimate atmosphere that invites listeners to discard old attitudes about "classical" music and re-enter the world of an earlier time when audiences engaged directly with the musicians in concerts. REVEL will perform for Chatter Cabaret on Sunday, December 1 at Hotel Andaluz.
