# String Trio Opus 45 (1946)

#### **Arnold Schoenberg** (1874–1951)

This 12-tone Trio unfolds as a single movement in three sections.

The first section functions as an exposition, the second as a sort of development, and the last as a shortened recapitulation and coda. The first two of these parts are further divided into two sections each. Color and timbre are of the utmost importance in the Trio; in addition to normal bowing, Schoenberg draws upon an extensive palette of playing techniques, including *ponticello, pizzicato*, harmonics, and *col legno*.
