

John Graham viola

John Graham's multi-faceted career as a soloist, chamber music ensemble artist and teacher has taken him throughout the US and to Canada, Europe, China, Taiwan, Korea and Japan.

During his twenty-five years as a top free-lance violist in New York he performed as soloist, in chamber music ensembles, in new music groups, symphony, ballet, and Broadway orchestras, in film, TV, and commercial recording. He subsequently taught for nineteen years at the Eastman School of Music of the University of Rochester and is now Professor Emeritus of Viola.

Mr. Graham was a long-time member of the Artist-Faculty of the Aspen Music Festival and School and has participated in the Marlboro, Santa Fe, Semaines Musicales (France) music festivals.

He has appeared as guest artist with the American, Guarneri, Juilliard, Mendelssohn, Tokyo and Ying Quartets. His recordings include a solo four-CD series entitled *Music for the Viola*, as well as issues of contemporary and conventional ensemble repertoire, including the complete viola quintets of Mozart with the Juilliard Quartet and quartets of Berg, Debussy and Ravel with the Galimir Quartet.
