Hampton Sides is the author of *Ghost Soldiers* and other bestselling works of narrative history. He is editor-at-large for *Outside Magazine* and has written for such periodicals as *National Geographic*, *The New Yorker*, *Esquire*, *Preservation*, and *Men's Journal*. His magazine work, collected in numerous published anthologies, has been twice nominated for National Magazine Awards for feature writing. *Ghost Soldiers*, a World War II narrative which has sold slightly over a million copies worldwide and has been translated into a dozen foreign languages, was the basis for the 2005 Miramax film, *The Great Raid*. Hampton's *Blood and Thunder*, about the life and times of controversial frontiersman Kit Carson, was named one of the 10 Best Books of 2006 by *Time* magazine and is currently under development for the screen. Hampton lives in New Mexico with his wife Anne and their three boys.
