wed was commissioned by the American Conservatory Theater in San francisco for the Kronos Quartet. wed is from a series of incidental pieces and songs written for the ACT's 1996 production of Shakespeare's play The Tempest, with music performed live by the Kronos. wed is a bittersweet interpretation of the wedding masque Prospero creates to entertain his daughter Miranda and her beloved Ferdinand.

wreck accompanies the shipwreck with which the play opens and it seeks to depict both the fury of the storm and the mathematical rigor of the alchemy needed to summon it.

Bitsui has published his poems in *Narrative, Black Renaissance Noir, American Poet, The Iowa Review, LIT,* and elsewhere. His poems were also anthologized in *Between Water & Song, Legitimate Dangers: American Poets of the New Century.* He is the author of *Shapeshift* (University of Arizona Press, 2003) and *Flood Song* (Copper Canyon Press, 2009).
