John Marchiando trumpet

Praised as "one of the finest trumpeters of his generation," John Marchiando currently serves as Visiting Assistant Professor at the University of New Mexico. Additionally, he performs as Principal Trumpet with the New Mexico Philharmonic, Trumpeter in the Summit Brass and Trumpeter in Tromba Mundi.

Marchiando appeared as Principal Trumpet with the New Mexico Symphony Orchestra from 2006–2011 and has also held positions with the Phoenix Symphony and Arizona Opera. He has performed as Guest Principal Trumpet with the Tucson Symphony Orchestra and Santa Fe Symphony and has appeared with many other notable ensembles such as the Santa Fe Opera, Chatter: A Chamber Ensemble, Santa Fe New Music and the Toledo Symphony.

V.B. Price has lived in New Mexico for 53 years, writing poems, social commentary, non-fiction books and novels. He teaches in the UNM Honors Program and in UNM School of Architecture and Planning. His newest book is *The Orphaned Land: New Mexico's Environment Since the Manhattan Project* from UNM Press in 2011.
