

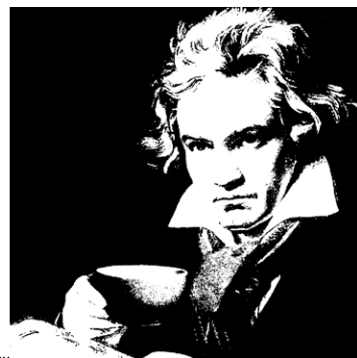

From 1989 until his move to New Mexico in 1997, MacAskie was an active performer in New York's jazz circle—playing acoustic piano and electronic keyboards with equal authority.

He has performed with a number of world-class jazz artists including Frank Morgan, Bill Watrous, Kevin Mahogany, Chris Calloway, and the New York Voices. MacAskie has also performed with pop stars Patti Page, Regis Philbin, John Davidson, Little Anthony & The Imperials, The Inkspots, The Platters, and Hassan Hakmoun.

He has recently returned to ABQ after spending a year living and working in Malaysia. He recorded and performed with top jazz and pop artists there, and taught at the National Arts Academy.

Excerpts from *Lullabies for My Father*

Lullabies for My Father is a collection of interviews and experiments on the subject of fathers that explores our relationships with the men we loved first. Hilarious, sometimes heart-breaking and highly entertaining, *Lullabies* is full of surprises. Partially created in "Verbatim Theater" style, *Lullabies* began as a collection of interviews with a diverse group of community members in and around Albuquerque. Students, lawyers, artists, small-business owners, government employees, men and women spoke candidly about their memories of and relationships with their fathers. The interviews were studied and the words and actions are precisely relayed by Tricklock actors; then shaken up with original text, improvisation, physical articulation, and comments and perspectives from blogs, online communities and social media sites. As this show tours internationally, more interviews will be collected and worked into the performance.
