

Known for his dreamy abstraction and the emotional ferocity of his work both on the page and on the stage, **Brendan Constantine** has helped to shape the poetry scenes of Southern California. He is an ardent supporter of Southern California's poetry communities and one of its most recognized poets. Mr. Constantine serves these communities as a teacher of poetry in local schools and colleges as well as hospitals, elder care centers and shelters for the homeless. His work has appeared in *Ploughshares*, *The Cortland Review*, and *RUNES*. Mr. Constantine is currently poet in residence at the Windward School in West Los Angeles and Loyola Marymount University Extension. He is also currently working with The Alzheimer's Poetry Project, bringing poetry workshops to Alzheimer's patients throughout the southland. In August 2011 he released *Birthday Girl with Possum*, poems by Brendan Constantine.
