

Valerie Martínez is a poet, translator, teacher, playwright, librettist, and collaborative artist. Her award-winning books include *Absence, Luminescent, World to World, A Flock of Scarlet Doves, Each and Her, And They Called It Horizon* and *This is How It Began.* Her most recent book, *Each and Her*, has been nominated for the Pulitzer Prize, the National Book Critics Circle Award, the PEN Open Book Award, the William Carlos William Award, and the National Book Award. Her work has been widely published in journals, magazines, anthologies and media outlets including *The Best American Poetry*, the *Washington Post*, and the Poetry Foundation's *Poetry Everywhere* series. She is Executive Director of Littleglobe, Inc, an artist-run non-profit that collaborates with communities on art and community dialogue projects. Valerie has a B.A. from Vassar College and an MFA from the University of Arizona. She was the Poet Laureate of Santa Fe, New Mexico for 2008-2010.
