Mary Oishi is the current City of Albuquerque Poet Laureate. Oishi is the author of *Spirit Birds They Told Me* (West End Press), and co-author with her daughter, Aja Oishi, of *Rock Paper Scissors* (Swimming with Elephants), finalist for the 2018 New Mexico Arizona Book Award. She is one of twelve U.S. poets in translation in *12 Poetas: Antología De Nuevos Poetas Estadounidenses*, a project of the Mexican Ministry of Culture. Oishi worked professionally and as an on-air personality in public radio for 25 years, longest as Development Director and Blues Show host at KUNM. She currently hosts Wang Dang Doodle, a weekly blues show on KSFR Santa Fe.
