Nathan Brown Spoken Word

Nathan Brown is an author, songwriter, and award-winning poet living in Wimberley, Texas. He holds a PhD in English and Journalism from the University of Oklahoma where he's taught for over 20 years. He served as Poet Laureate for the State of Oklahoma in 2013/14, and now travels full-time performing readings, concerts, workshops and speaking on creativity, poetry, and songwriting. Nathan has published 25 books. Most recent is his new collection of poems, *In the Days of Our Resilience*, the fourth in a series now known as the *Pandemic Poems Project*, that deals with the year of the pandemic, and a new travel memoir *Just Another Honeymoon in France: A Vagabond at Large. Karma Crisis: New and Selected Poems* was a finalist for the Paterson Poetry Prize. His earlier book, *Two Tables Over*, won the Oklahoma Book Award. He's taught memoir, poetry, songwriting, and performance workshops from Tuscany and Ireland to the Sisters Folk Festival in Oregon, the Taos Poetry Festival, the Woody Guthrie Festival, Laity Lodge, the Everwood Farmstead Foundation in Wisconsin, as well as for Blue Rock Artist Ranch near Austin, Texas.
