“The Walkings” are a series of short texts by AJ Sabatini for spoken word performances set to William Duckworth’s *Time Curve Preludes*. Sabatini became the voice of a character known as The Chronicler for Duckworth and Nora Farrell’s elaborate live and online projects, *Cathedral* and *iOrpheus*, from 2001–2010. The texts touch on memories, reflections, friendship, loss, and walks through music and time.

A.J. Sabatini Spoken Word

AJ Sabatini (Arthur J. Sabatini) is a writer, scholar, performer, and collaborating artist. He began writing on the arts in Philadelphia, earned a PhD from New York University, and was a founding member of the Interdisciplinary Arts and Performance program at Arizona State University, where he is now Emeritus Professor of Performance Studies. He has published widely with notable writing on John Cage, Robert Ashley, Lee Breuer, Daniel Lentz, Fred Ho and others. He has been involved in new music and performance with Rêlache, The Ensemble for Contemporary Music, William Duckworth & Nora Farrell’s Cathedral Band and the iOrpheus Project. His theater and performance works include *Magical Walking/Certain Explanations*, *Who Walks* and *The Walkings*, and he is currently preparing a collection of essays and creative writing.

Today’s concert is in memory of local composer Daniel Davis (1953–2022) whose curiosity, imagination, joyful spirit and great good humor will continue to live on in all of his beautiful music.
