## Jon Davis Spoken Word

Jon Davis is the author of fourteen poetry collections, including, most recently, *Fearless Now & Nameless*, from Grid Books. Davis also co-translated Iraqi poet Naseer Hassan's *Dayplaces* (Tebot Bach, 2017). He has received a Lannan Literary Award, the Lavan Prize from the Academy of American Poets, and two National Endowment for the Arts Fellowships. He taught creative writing and literature for thirty years, twenty-eight of them at the Institute of American Indian Arts. In 2013, he founded the Low Residency MFA in Creative Writing at IAIA, which he directed until his retirement in 2018. From 2012–2014, he served as the City of Santa Fe's fourth poet laureate. He maintains a website at [jondavispoet.com](http://jondavispoet.com). In January of 2024, Davis and poet/guitarist Greg Glazner formed the band *Clap the Houses Dark*. Their first album, which mixes poetic language with complex rock compositions, is streaming on all major platforms.
