He served as Poet Laureate for the State of Oklahoma in 2013/14 and travels full-time performing readings, concerts, workshops and speaking on creativity, poetry, and songwriting.

Nathan has published over 25 books. Most recent is his new memoir, *The Fallen Autumn: The Birth of a Vagabond—Book 2. Karma Crisis: New and Selected Poems* was a finalist for the Paterson Poetry Prize and the Oklahoma Book Award. His earlier book, *Two Tables Over*, won the Oklahoma Book Award. His latest album of all original songs, *The Streets of San Miguel*, features Paul Simon's accordionist, Joel Guzman, and international fiddle champion Warren Hood.
