Jessica Helen Lopez is the City of Albuquerque Poet Laureate Emerita (2014–2016) and the author of five collections of poetry, including *The Blood Poems* (UNM Press, 2021) and *My Heart is a Pomegranate* (FlowerSong Press, 2024). A California-born Xicana by way of Deming, NM and the surrounding frontera communities of Las Cruces and El Paso, Lopez is a Justice for Migrant Women's Collective Rural Women's Fellow and a Pushcart Prize for Poetry nominee. She is also an educator at the Native American Community Academy for the Institute of American Indian Arts and teaches for the UNM Chicana and Chicano Studies Department.
