Anthony Hunt Spoken Word

Far away, and very long ago, as an undergraduate struggling to pay attention in an economics class, Anthony Hunt began writing poems . . . and has never stopped. A retired university professor, with a well-received scholarly book (2004) on Gary Snyder's epic masterpiece, *Mountains and Rivers Without End*, in November 2015 he was a keynote speaker on Snyder's poetry at an international symposium on "Literature and Ecology" at Hunan University (Changsha, China). In 2022 he co-edited the Library of America's volume of Snyder's *Collected Poems*. Over the years he has taught courses in literature and writing in Nigeria, Maine, Puerto Rico, Poland, Croatia, Taiwan, and here in New Mexico; during that time his own poetry has appeared in various literary magazines. In 2008, after attending the original performance of the Church of Beethoven (aka Sunday Chatter) it was his suggestion to include a spoken word interval . . . and he became its first poet.
