Margaret Randall Spoken Word

Poet, photographer, translator and social activist Margaret Randall was born in New York City but grew up in New Mexico. Taking active part in the Mexican Student Movement of 1968 and then living in Cuba for eleven years and Nicaragua for four, Randall returned to the land of her birth in 1984 only to face deportation when the government declared her writing “against the good order and happiness of the United States.” With the support of many, she won her case in 1989. Randall is the author of more than 200 books, most recently *Wild Card* (poems) and *Letters from the Edge: Outrider Conversations* (based on correspondence to and from longtime friends). She received the “Poet of Two Hemispheres” award from Poesía en Paralelo Cero in Ecuador, AWP’s George Garrett award, Albuquerque’s Creative Bravo award, and an Honorary Doctorate in Letters from the University of New Mexico, among other recognitions.
