Eszter Balint Spoken Word

Eszter Balint is a Hungarian-American singer-songwriter, violinist and actress who started performing at the age of 4 at the legendary avant garde Squat Theatre in NY, founded by her parents, who enjoyed close ties with Budapest's foremost artists including the composer György Kurtág. She made her feature film debut in Jim Jarmusch's *Stranger Than Paradise* and was nominated for the Independent Spirit Award for Best Female Lead for *Bail Jumper*. She was also featured in *Shadows and Fog*, *Trees Lounge*, *Downtown 81*, starred alongside David Bowie and Rosanna Arquette in *The Linguini Incident* and was featured in Chantal Akerman's *American Stories* and Jarmusch's *The Dead Don't Die*. She had a recurring starring role as Amia in the fourth season of Louis C.K.'s FX series *Louie*.

Eszter has performed and recorded with John Zorn, Marc Ribot, John Lurie, Rammellzee, Elliott Sharp, Michael Gira, and many others. She has recorded four of her own critically acclaimed albums. The most recent *Hate Memory!* is based on a song cycle tracing her journey from communist Hungary as a child member of her father's radical theater group, to a vibrant arts community in downtown New York City. The show has been performed regularly at Joe's Pub, part of Joe Papp's Public Theatre in NYC. At Chatter, she'll be performing "Before America," a spoken word selection from that show.
